## **MAYVIEW COMMUNITY HEALTH CENTER**

MayView Community Health Clinic is a local non-profit organization devoted to providing essential primary health care services to low-income families and individuals who live and work in the northern part of Santa Clara County and the southernmost part of San Mateo County, providing general medical and preventative care to children and adults, special programs, family planning and comprehensive perinatal services. The physicians at MayView practice family-based primary care, with the capacity to deal with more complex health problems, chronic illnesses and participation in mandated managed care programs.

Palo Alto Rotary Charities has granted \$7,500 to MayView Community Health Clinic to support free tuberculosis screening and treatment for the high risk immigrant population served at the MayView Clinic in Palo Alto.
